### To Indulge: From Penny Candy to Chocolate to Ice Cream

"I've always wanted to do candy and ice cream," said Kelly Jaime, who, with his wife, Glyn, owns the Sweet Shop NYC. His slice of nostalgia is crammed with what was once called penny candy, as well as novelties like chocolate "Band-Aids," lots of licorice, some fine chocolates and, for those with long memories, Elk Candy marzipan from the company that once had a shop in Yorkville.
